 - 1. Vote on budget: Treasurer shared the budget. \$4,000 in donations and community partnerships: Kroger, C2C and Spirit Nights. Budget is very similar to last year with the exception of combining hospitality, teacher/staff appreciation and students support individual accounts into one big account: Teacher/Staff App/Hospitality/Student Support are now all together. Budget will end year with approx \$3,400 (bylaws state \$3,000 to pay for spirit wear) so we will be in good shape for the upcoming year.
